

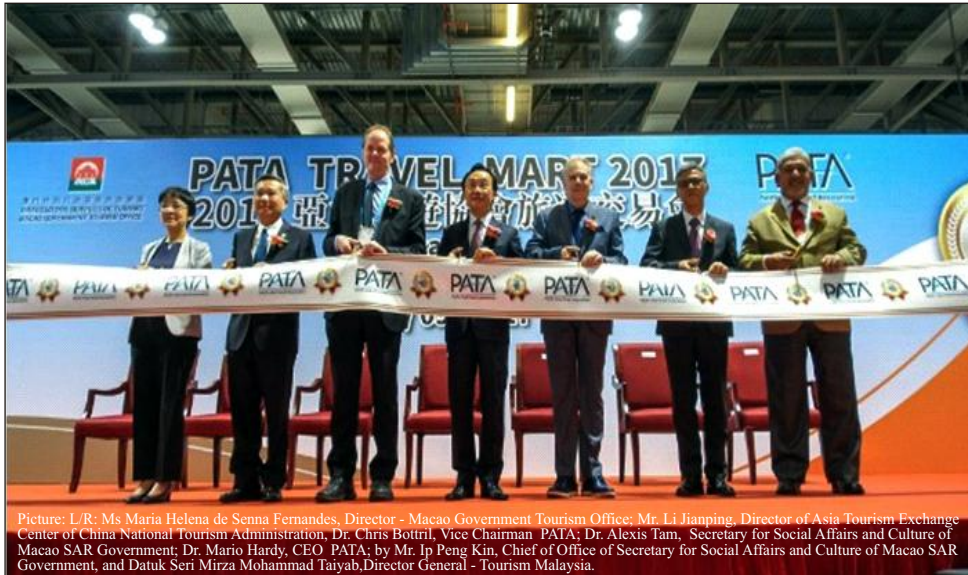

Macao SAR welcomes over 1,100 delegates to PATA Travel Mart 2017

MACAO SAR, September 15, 2017 The 40th edition of [PATA Travel Mart 2017](#) (PTM 2017), hosted by the Macao Government Tourism Office (MGTO), has attracted 1,131 delegates from 66 global destinations. The delegate numbers embraced 460 sellers from 252 organisations and 37 destinations, along with 293 buyers from 281 organisations and 51 source markets. PTM 2017 officially opened in Macao SAR on September 13.

PATA CEO Dr. Mario Hardy paid tribute to warm and sincere welcome offered to all delegates by the host city. “It was very recently that Macao was hit hard by Typhoon Hato and, while recovery works

are continuing, the city's return to normality and amazing welcome is testament to the resilience of its people.”

MGTO Director Ms Maria Helena de Senna Fernandes said, “Each year, PATA Travel Mart helps to bring to the limelight the host destination, and for this edition Macao is excited to take the opportunity to show our new tourism attractions that have come into operation since we last met in our city in 2010.

“As Macao welcomes PATA Travel Mart 2017, its 40th edition, we are encouraged that, together with MGTO, around 30 of our local tourism operators are participating at the travel mart, and taking

AKOYA - A new generation of private seaplanes



July, 19th 2017 Bourget du Lac - A few months before the first deliveries, the AKOYA, a small private plane developed by the French company LISA Airplanes, will be offering a new way to travel. Unique in the world, this aircraft with its innovative design can land on water, snow, and land. When it arrives at its destination, the aircraft's wings can be folded in an instant, enabling it to be stored, quite simply, in a garage. This aircraft, which is jam-packed with technologies, will completely transform light aviation. If you wish to embark on a journey around Europe, you will be able to do so with great ease by taking off, for example, at the foot of the Alps and landing on water to dine at a restaurant in Sicily, or next to your yacht in the Greek islands. The AKOYA's versatility, combined with its range of 2,000 km (1,250 miles) and maximum speed of 250 km/h (155mph), considerably increases the number of possible destinations.

The project was developed by a small team of passionate people in the heart of the French Alps. The specifications were more than ambitious: the aim was to create an "all-terrain" aircraft that is aesthetically pleasing, comfortable, easy to fly and performs well. In short, a high-quality aircraft that does not compromise on performance.

To achieve this goal, the LISA team had to employ all its ingenuity and go beyond the traditional boundaries of aviation.

Hence, one of the AKOYA's many features is the use of "Seafoil" technology patented technology developed by LISA Airplanes to enable the aircraft to take off from water. A major asset, the small wings that are like fins under the aircraft are similar to hydrofoils, which are now revolutionizing the world of sailing. Thanks to the "Seafoils," the AKOYA has freed itself

from traditional forms and devices in order to operate on water, and has thus become the first seaplane that performs well in the air and is easy to fly.

Another feature of the aircraft, the AKOYA's retractable landing gear is fitted with wheels and skis, enabling the pilot to land on both snow and land. It is therefore the only aircraft in the world that can take off from snow-covered terrain and land in a lagoon. The AKOYA has many other advantages. It has folding wings that enable the aircraft to be easily stored and transported. It adds more safety features with its high-quality material and its integrated parachute that will enable the aircraft and the passengers to land safely in case of emergency. Its high-end finishes which are entirely customizable complete the list and transform the AKOYA into a real unique aircraft.

Extraordinary donation honors 100 years of French-American aviation relationship

Oshkosh, Wisconsin, USA, August 31, 2017 In a donation honoring 100 years of the French-American aviation relationship, a full-sized Morane-Saulnier Type L “Parasol” aeroplane replica will join the prestigious Experimental Aircraft Association’s EAA Aviation Museum collection in Oshkosh, Wisconsin. This hand-crafted reproduction of the World War I-era Parasol – an ancestor of Daher’s TBM very fast turboprop aircraft family – was brought by Daher to the U.S. for an appearance at last month’s EAA AirVenture Oshkosh fly-in. During the week-long event, the aeroplane was a major draw, attracting a steady flow of visitors. While the Type L originally was planned for a return to France, it was decided to

honor the EAA’s request that the replica be permanently exhibited at the EAA Aviation Museum. It is to be situated near the facility’s entrance, between the historic reproductions of the Wright brothers’ Wright Flyer and Charles Lindbergh’s Spirit of St. Louis. The six-year construction effort for the Type L Parasol replica was managed by the Association Héritage Avions Morane-Saulnier, whose volunteers – both retired and current workers of Daher and predecessor companies (including some Morane-Saulnier veterans in their mid-80s) – contributed their skills, energy and passion. Daher supported the Type L replica project from the start, providing workspace, tooling and expertise. The flightworthy replica retains the Type L Parasol’s original wooden structure

configuration, along with its wing-warping system and the aircraft’s all-flying rudder and stabilator controls.

“The response to the Type L’s presence from EAA AirVenture Oshkosh attendees, including members of our global TBM community, was very impressive,” said Nicolas Chabbert, senior Vice President of Daher Airplane Business Unit. “When the opportunity came to include this element of aviation history in the EAA Aviation Museum, we were pleased that the Association Héritage Avions Morane-Saulnier agreed – and Daher fully supports the decision.”

As a result of the donation, Daher has offered to sponsor the construction of a second flightworthy Type L replica, which will be produced and based in France. “Our team of dedicated volunteers are extremely proud to have the Parasol included in the EAA Aviation Museum, which is recognized worldwide for the quality and range of its collection,” commented Daniel Bacou, President of the Association Héritage Avions Morane-Saulnier. “Of course, it was difficult to part ways with the aircraft after six years of hard work, but we thank Daher for the very generous offer that enables us to embark on a new exciting project for the second reproduction.”

“The Parasol was an extremely important aircraft to the Allied powers of World War I and an important symbol of the friendship between France and the United States during the war,” said Bob Campbell, Director of the EAA Aviation Museum. “We are most honored and proud to accept this replica in the same spirit shared between our two great nations during that conflict.”

Karson Kowalchuk, who won gold and broke the Canada Games record in the Men's 100m.

Hanna Henderson, who won 11 medals in various female swimming events - beating the previous Canada Games record of 9 medals won by one athlete.

Canada condemns escalating violence in Myanmar

September 1, 2017 - Ottawa, Canada - Global Affairs Canada

The Honourable Chrystia Freeland, Minister of Foreign Affairs, together with the Honourable Marie-Claude Bibeau, Minister of International Development and La Francophonie today issued the following statement on the situation in Myanmar:

"Canada strongly condemns the escalating violence and its impact on innocent people in northern Rakhine State and calls for calm. We urge all parties involved to exercise restraint and to ensure the safety, protection and support for civilians including the Rohingya. The Government of Canada encourages the authorities in Myanmar to take measures to facilitate the continued delivery of humanitarian assistance and calls for the full resumption of assistance activities in a timely manner.

"Canada remains concerned about the safety of civilians crossing or trying to cross the border into Bangladesh. We recognize the additional challenges hosting refugees can place on the country's infrastructure and resources, and appreciate Bangladesh's efforts in assisting many asylum seekers. In 2017, we have provided \$1.13 million in humanitarian assistance in Bangladesh to meet the needs of conflict-affected people, including the Rohingya, in addition to the

\$4.5 million in assistance we are providing to vulnerable populations in Myanmar.

"Canada is encouraged by the Government of Myanmar's commitment to carry out the recommendations contained in the final report of the Kofi Annan-led Advisory Commission on Rakhine State and looks forward to their timely implementation in line with the principles of democracy and the rule of law."

Canada crowned FIBA Women's AmeriCup 2017 champion



AUGUST 13 2017

BUENOS AIRES (FIBA Women's AmeriCup 2017) Canada revalidated as FIBA Women's AmeriCup Champion with a 67-65 win over Argentina. Nirra Fields was named the FIBA Women's AmeriCup 2017 Most Valuable Player. For the first time in the continental competition, Canada had a slow start and Argentina took full advantage, with great additions from Melisa Gretter, who had 15-points in the first half. With a suffocating defense, the Argentines carried a 7-point lead into half-time. Canada looked better on both sides of the court for the start of the second half, as it took over the lead for the first time with a 29-13 third quarter. Argentina closed the gap to one point, and the crowd took over the game. Canada held-on to the difference like a true-veteran and celebrated the win. Canada dominated the battle for the boards 52-39 and Kia Nurse led the scoring for the back-to-back champions with 12 points.

Nirra Fields was named MVP of the FIBA Women's AmeriCup after averaging 14.5 points in the tournament. The All-Star Five

of the tournament were Melisa Gretter (ARG), Nirra Fields (CAN), Allison Gibson (PUR), Paola Ferrari (PAR) and Miranda Ayim (CAN). Puerto Rico captured the Bronze Medal of the FIBA Women's AmeriCup 2017 and secured a historic first trip to the FIBA Women's Basketball World Cup 2018, with a 75-68 win over Brazil. Led offensively by 19 points from Allison Gibson, the Puerto Ricans came from behind and took the top of the scoreboard during the second half. Brazil fought hard, but the Boricuas secured the momentous win from the free-throw line.

FIBA appoints TORNEOS to distribute broadcast rights in Latin and South America



MIES, Switzerland/BUENOS AIRES, Argentina - FIBA announced on Thursday it has put South American leading sports marketing and media company TORNEOS in charge of overseeing the distribution of broadcast rights for its leading competitions over the period 2017-2025.

Under the agreement, TORNEOS acts on behalf of basketball's world governing body in striking up broadcast agreements for the distribution rights to FIBA's top national team events across Latin and South America. The result is an unprecedented coverage of FIBA national team competitions in the Americas.

The partnership involves the distribution of linear broadcast rights for all of FIBA's major national team competitions during the period. This includes the FIBA Basketball World Cups 2019 and 2023 and their Qualifiers, the FIBA AmeriCups 2017, 2021 and 2025 and their Qualifiers, the FIBA Women's Basketball World Cups 2018 and 2022, all other FIBA Continental Cups (Men and Women) as well as the FIBA U17 and U19 Basketball World Cups (Men and Women).

On behalf of FIBA, TORNEOS will reach out to broadcasters in the following countries and territories: Anguilla, Antigua, Argentina, Aruba, Barbados, Belize, Bolivia, British Virgin Islands, Cayman Islands, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Dominica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Grenada, Guatemala, Guyana, Haiti, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Monserrat, Nicaragua, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Puerto Rico, St Kitts & Nevis, St Lucia, St Vincent & the Grenadines, Surinam, Turks & Caicos Islands, Trinidad & Tobago, Uruguay, Venezuela.

Additionally, TORNEOS will partner with FIBA to provide the local production facilities required for each national team's games in the Americas during the Qualifiers, with the exception of Brazil, Canada and the USA.

Santiago Sluzewski Monti, Rights Director at TORNEOS, said: "FIBA's new competition system will provide the opportunity to showcase on a regular basis the national teams from the Americas participating in FIBA events, starting with the FIBA AmeriCups (Men and Women) and leading up to the FIBA Basketball World Cups (Men and Women). Our main goal is to work jointly with FIBA to reach every basketball fan in the region and promote FIBA events across the Americas."

Belgium crowned U18 Women's European champions

SOPRON, Hungary (FIBA U18 Women's European Championship 2017) - Belgium are the FIBA U18 Women's European Championship 2017 champions, defeating Serbia 55-53 in Sunday's Final in Sopron, Hungary.

Led by tournament MVP Billie Massey, Belgium used a 22-3 second quarter to build a commanding lead, only for Serbia to charge back from 19 points down, to be leading going into the final minute. However, Seraphine Bastin showed a cool head from the line, converting 3-of-4 free throws inside the last 40 seconds to seal

the game.

Serbia had a chance to win on the buzzer, but Nevana Dimitrijevic's shot over two defenders was off the mark.

It is the first time Belgium have won a women's youth medal since 2011, with the title on that occasion also coming at U18 level. The medal marks a continuation of a remarkable summer for Belgium basketball, following on from the bronze they won at FIBA EuroBasket Women 2017.
