

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

GOVERNMENTS OF CANADA AND MANITOBA SIGN 10-YEAR HOUSING AGREEMENT

WINNIPEG—Families, Indigenous communities and vulnerable Canadians in need of an affordable place to call home can count on long-term funding for community housing in Manitoba thanks to an agreement signed today by the federal and provincial governments.

Today in Winnipeg, Adam Vaughan, parliamentary secretary to the Minister of Families, Children and Social Development (Housing and Urban Affairs), on behalf of the Honourable Jean-Yves Duclos, Canada's Minister of Families. Children and Social Development and Minister Responsible for Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC), along with the Manitoba Families Minister Heather Stefanson. announced they have reached a bilateral agreement under the National Housing Strategy (NHS). This agreement, which will be cost-shared by the governments of Canada and Manitoba, demonstrates a joint commitment to prioritize affordable housing. The 10-year agreement will invest almost \$450.8 million to protect, renew and expand social and community housing, and support Manitoba's priorities related to housing repair, construction and affordability. 
