## BRITISH AIRWAYS ANNOUNCES ROUTES AND STARTS SELLING SEATS FOR ITS NEW GATWICK SHORT-HAUL SUBSIDIARY

Today British Airways has revealed the initial destinations for its new Gatwick subsidiary, which will start flying from March 2022. Tickets to 35 short-haul destinations will also be on sale from Tuesday 14 December.

The airline announced its intention to create a short-haul standalone business at Gatwick in August, similar to its operation from London City Airport, which operates under the British Airways name but exists as an entirely separate entity. The offshoot will launch later in 2022, with short-haul services at Gatwick being operated by mainline BA until the new entities' Air Operators Certificate is issued. BA short-haul flights will start operating from Gatwick at the end of March, with three Airbus short-haul aircraft initially, ramping up to 18 aircraft by the end of May.

The subsidiary will herald the airline's return to short-haul flying from the London airport, which had been suspended as a result of Covid-19 in Spring 2020. During the pandemic, several routes were moved to Heathrow airport, some of which will return to Gatwick, as well as being maintained at Heathrow to give customers choice, including Faro, Ibiza, Malaga, Marrakech and Tenerife. In addition, other new routes will be added at Gatwick including Athens,

Berlin, Madrid, Milan Malpensa and Santorini. The new services will be branded and known as British Airways\*. Customers will receive the same high level of service they expect of British Airways as well as enjoying the benefits of travelling with the UK's flag carrier including a generous baggage allowance, free water and snacks, free seat selection at - 24 hours and frequent flyer benefits which include lounge access.

## Daher's multi-mission Kodiak 100 aircraft will deploy paratroopers to test military parachutes for France's defense procurement agency

Paratroopers from the French military's School of Airborne Troops (ETAP) have performed training jumps from Hélicoptère's Kodiak 100. Daher's multi-mission Kodiak 100 aircraft will deploy paratroopers to test military parachutes for France's defense procurement agency Tarbes, France, December 22, 2021 – Hélicoptère, the first operator of Daher's Kodiak 100 multi-mission aircraft in France, has been contracted by the country's defense procurement agency to perform paratroop drops that will test and validate parachute systems for the French armed forces. This contract was awarded by the aeronautical techniques expert center of France's General Directorate of Armament (DGA-AT), and it covers the rental of a Hélicoptère Kodiak 100 for a period of five years at the rate of 200 flight hours annually. "The contract acknowledges our Kodiak 100's multi-mission efficiency and performance, as well as the quality of Hélicoptère's flight operations," said Nicolas Chabbert, the Senior Vice President of Daher's Aircraft Division. "It also represents another DGA recognition of Daher's products and services. We have performed operational support maintenance for the DGA's TBM 700 very fast aircraft during nearly 30 years, along with avionics modernization on its helicopters. More recently, the DGA ordered a fleet of four new TBM 940s for its support and training missions – with all of these aircraft now delivered." Hélicoptère operates two Kodiak 100s, both of which entered service with the company earlier this year in southwestern France. One of them is equipped for the deployment of paratroopers,



and it already has logged nearly 200 flight hours while performing some 600 rotations for civilian skydiving centers in France.

The Kodiak 100 is to be used in parachute testing for French armed forces. The Hélicoptère Kodiak 100 also has welcomed students from the French military's School of Airborne Troops (ETAP), which trains paratroopers for the country's armed forces and its Gendarmerie national police force. Based at Pau-Pyrénées airport, Hélicoptère performs transportation and aerial work with both fixed-wing airplanes and helicopters, while also providing aviation maintenance, training and consulting services.
